The Network Room

The Network Room provides computers to access the Internet and word processing programs; phones to make job contacts; and notebooks with printed job leads. Computer use is limited to job search and educational activities.

Community Computer Lab

The Community Computer Lab provides access to the Internet and Microsoft Office programs. You can use self-guided tutorial programs to learn typing skills and Microsoft Office programs. Computer use is limited to job search and educational activities.

GED/ABE Classes
