## Jobs on the Outside

Jobs on the Outside (JOTO) is a comprehensive, collaborative initiative that provides individuals with a criminal record with skills training, job search assistance, job placement assistance and other services as an alternative answer to recidivism.

Recidivism is the tendency to relapse into criminal behavior and risk being arrested and reincarcerated. The risk of recidivism decreases with employment and healthy family relationships, among other things.

The JOTO initiative educates our surrounding communities and area businesses about the opportunity to reduce recidivist behavior by providing gainful employment.

This effort underscores the reality that businesses have a positive and vital role in making our communities safer and more economically viable places to live and work.

To be eligible to participate, individuals must be at least 16 years old, have a criminal record as a barrier to employment, and reside in Guilford, Randolph or Rockingham County.

All ex-offenders can receive job search assistance and referrals for other resources.
